



## TREE EXEMPTION APPLICATION AND SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS

Trees that meet any of the exemption criteria stated in BDMC 19.30.050 are exempt from requiring a level I or level II tree permit.

In addition, any tree less than six (6) inches diameter at breast height or those included on the following list, regardless of the size, are exempt:

1. Black Locust (*Robinia pseudoacacia*)
2. Cottonwood (*Populus freemontii*)
3. Native alder (Native *Alnus* only)
4. Native willow (Native *Salix* only)
5. Lombardy poplar (*Populus nigra*)

**Submittal Requirements:**

1. Sensitive Areas ID form
2. Aerial image or site plan showing
  - a. Property lines
  - b. Structures/improvements on site
  - c. Any critical areas on site
  - d. Identify all significant trees (over 6" in diameter) on site.
  - e. Identify location, species and size of all trees to be removed,
  - f. Identify location, species and size of all trees to be replaced, if applicable
3. If trees are hazardous or diseased, the Community Development Department may require additional information such as:
  - a. Narrative describing tree condition
  - b. Photographs showing tree condition
  - c. A statement from a certified arborist recommending removal of the tree.
4. If project is within 200 feet of Lake Sawyer additional restrictions may apply per the Shoreline Master Program.
